



Purpose: This microgrant is designed to provide additional support and/or opportunity to local Westgate and Westgate adjacent businesses.

Eligibility: Only businesses located within the 43204 zip code who have been operating more than 1 year are eligible. Business must be located within the Westgate boundaries or directly adjacent. Westgate is bounded from Hague Avenue to Demorest Road and West Broad Street to Sullivant Avenue.

Maximum Grant Award: \$1,000 (if awarded, grant amount may be lower)

Frequency of Award: Microgrant will be awarded once, per calendar year.

Deadline for application: June 30th of current calendar year.

Reporting: Following a successful application, the applicant will be required to provide a brief report that describes how the microgrant was used and the number of people impacted, and did you see a return on investment?
